ARTICLE II. MEMBERSHIP

AMENDMENT 1.

2.1 Election and Qualification

(d) Honorary Membership

Physicians from institutions who do not have a clear path on the Chandler Grant Glaucoma Society Legacy tree, and have demonstrated distinction in the field of glaucoma (via teaching, research, or treatment), who are training glaucoma fellows in programs with preceptors who are Chandler Grant Glaucoma Society members, shall be eligible for honorary membership. Honorary members shall have all the privileges of members except the right to vote. Officers may confer or revoke honorary membership by a majority vote.

(i.) Eligibility includes - Physicians who have participated in a glaucoma fellowship of not less than one year recognized by the Ophthalmic Fellowship Match of the AUPO. Candidates are waived from the requirement to have been precepted and nominated by a member of the Society during Fellowship. A candidate must be a Fellowship preceptor where one or more preceptors are CGGS members.

(ii) Election – Physicians applying for honorary membership shall submit an application outlined in the form and with the information and supporting materials* required by the Board of Directors or Membership Chair if one has been appointed. The list of honorary member candidates and their applications will be sent to the Board for approval twice a year. A ballot will be created from the Board-approved candidates and will be sent to members for approval. Candidates receiving affirmative votes from at least two-thirds of members responding, will be selected for membership.

Rationale:

Permits faculty who are interested in becoming a member, but do not have a direct path on the CGGS legacy tree to apply for membership.
