## **ARTICLE II**

### **MEMBERS**

2.1 Election and Qualification. Membership of the corporation shall consist of members and emeritus members. Total membership in the corporation, exclusive of emeritus members, shall not exceed 175 members.

(a) Members. Members shall initially consist of physicians who were members of the Chandler-Grant Society, an unincorporated association, immediately prior to the formation of the corporation. Other physicians shall be elected pursuant to Sections 2.1(b) if they first fulfill either of the following eligibility criteria:

- (i) Glaucoma specialists trained in Boston, Massachusetts, prior to July 1, 1994; or
- (ii) Physicians who have participated in a one-year glaucoma fellowship recognized by the Ophthalmic Fellowship Match of the AUPO, who have been precepted by a member of the corporation during such fellowship and who have been nominated for membership by their member preceptor.

(b) Election. Physicians seeking membership who are eligible under Section 2.1(a)(I) or (ii) shall submit an application in the form and with the information and supporting materials required by the Membership Committee, which requirements may be different depending on the membership criteria under which the applicant is applying. The Membership Committee shall consider the application and submit a list of candidates and their applications to the Board for approval once every year. The Board shall mail a ballot to the members that shall contain the list of Board-approved candidates. Candidates receiving affirmative votes from at least two-thirds of members responding and who are among the ten candidates receiving the highest number of affirmative votes for that year shall be selected as members.

(c) Emeritus Members. All members who voluntarily retired or who reach the age of 65 shall be emeritus members. Emeritus members shall have no right to notice of or to vote at any meeting, shall not be considered for purposes of establishing a quorum, shall not be required to pay dues or attend meetings, and shall have no other rights or responsibilities. An emeritus member shall, however, be permitted to hold any office of the corporation.
